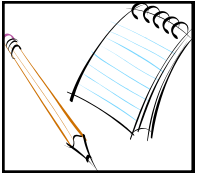

HAPA Board of Directors February Meeting MINUTES

On February 21, 2008 A regular meeting of the Hicks Airfield Pilots Association Board of Directors was held in accordance with the association's declaration and bylaws. Board Members and Officers attending were Gene de Bullet, Don Browning, Stuart Davis, Ted Kelso, Coy Surles and Jim Usher. Also present were HAPA member, Mike Olson and Carol Moran, representing PMG. Absent were Stephen Ramsey and John Unangst.

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 6:32 P.M. by president, Gene de Bullet. Introduction was then made of HAPA member, Mike Olson, who was asked to chair the taxiway repair committee. Mr. Olson tentatively agreed to serve.

Approval of Prior Month's Minutes: The January minutes were approved as written.

Reports of Officers: President de Bullet expressed the need for Board Members to approve **both the minutes and treasurer's report prior to publication. Motion was made and seconded.** Discussion was held and the motion passed with all in favor.

Reports of Committees: It was announced that the 2008 Committees are:

Architectural – Stuart Davis, Chairman
Electrical – Robert Avery, Chairman
Safety/Security – Larry Partain, Chairman
Septic – Ted Kelso and Stephen Ramsey, Co-Chairmen
South Gate – Jim Usher, Chairman
Taxiway Repair – Mike Olson, Chairman
Welcoming – Don Browning
Social/Educational – Coy Surles

Old Business:

- A. Security - The Board reviewed the continued need for security and options available to **them. It was decided to wait for Stephen Ramsey's report before a decision is made.**
- B. South Gate Installation - Ted Kelso volunteered to speak to Burlington Northern on behalf of HAPA regarding ownership of the property.
- C. Taxiway Repairs - The need for an accessible electrical switch to the Taxiway/Runway lights was discussed and it was decided to ask Ronnie Morgan to give an estimate for repairs for that and the repair/replacement of the burned wire to septic system near hangar 141.

New Business:

1. Spencer Hodge Bid - The Board voted unanimously to accept the bid of \$1,375.00 to connect the HAPA meter.
2. Website - Discussion of the HAPA website was held. It was unanimously agreed to authorize Ted Kelso to secure the domain name. The Board also unanimously voted to allocate \$2,000.00 for the set-up and design of the website.
3. Septic Line Repair - Authorization to spend up to \$2,000.00 for repair/replacement of suspected broken pipes near hangars 137 and 149 was given to Ted Kelso by unanimous decision.

4. Vote on Determination of License Fee - PMG was instructed to contact David Surratt with Riddle and Williams to implement the creation of a ballot to follow the court ordered election of the License Fee for Board approval.
5. Safe Hit - Presentation was made of Safe Hit, a product to enhance the safety of the airport. After discussion the decision was made to unanimously approve the allocation of \$1,000.00 for the installation of these devices at both ends of the runway.

Adjournment: There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 8:10 P.M.
